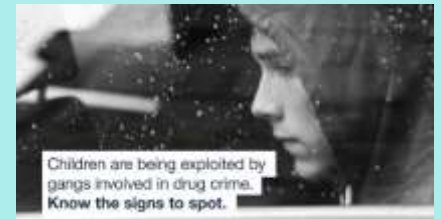


The Session:
